#### WORD, IS INCORRUPTIBLE

Some feel that when the Word does not bring forth immediate results, the sower has failed. But remember that the Word of God is living. Also, that it is incorruptible and that it abideth forever. If the Word of God does not give life to the hearer, it will one day face that same man in the day of judgment. "He that rejecteth me and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day" (John 12:48). So it is the responsibility of the sower to sow God will either the seed. give life to the hearer or if a man rejects the Word, he must give an account to God. Man is responsible to hear the Word of God. We are responsible to preach the gospel to every creature. are responsible to hear. And above all that, God is taking out a people for Himself according to the good pleasure of His own will.

#### WORD IS EFFECTUAL

When we preach the Word, it will always be effectual. Baptist need to ponder Isaiah 55:11 carefully. God's Word .... "shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it." It will not return unto Him void.

#### LIFE A MYSTERY

Just as life from any

seed is a mystery, even so the new birth is a mystery. The only answer to both is God. God gives it life. God is sovereign and gives life to those that are His sheep. We must sow the seed. We lie down and sleep, but the Word of God is working in the hearts of the hearers, convicting them. Many times we witness to a person and we rest in peace, but the hearer cannot sleep as God does His by the living Word. When God begins a good work with the Word, He will finish it. (Philemon 1:6)

#### CONCLUSION

Our responsibility is to sow the seed. God will use it either to the saving of souls or the judgment of the lost. Either way, we have assumed our responsibility and the blood of men is off of our hands.

May God help pastors to encourage all of our church members to sow the seed. Not just from the pulpit but from every child of God. ## THE CHRISTIAN HOPE

As preached in Titusville, Florida on October 19, 1930.

"For we are saved by hope. But hope that is seen is not hope; for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?" Romans 8:24.

"Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God Savior. our Christ." Titus 2:13.

See also; Romans 5:2; Colossians 1:5; I Peter 1:3; 1:13: I Peter 1:21: 3:15: and Hebrews 6:19.

The word "hope" is used in a very careless way in much of our modern speech; but, in the Bible the word is used with great care, and acuracy. Some use the word imply to express an uncertainty or doubt. Let us remember that the word is always used in the Bible in respect to the future. We do not hope for some thing we already have. The things hoped for must be waited for. But a mere wish about the future is not the believer's Get this definition: "Hope is a well-founded expectation for future good." Any wish or expectation that is not well-founded is not hope. Hope is that grace of the soul that looks forward to the fulfillment of the exceeding great and precious promises of our God. makes a promise, faith appropriates it, hope begins to 1/ook forward to the fulfillment of it, and patience waits for it.
